

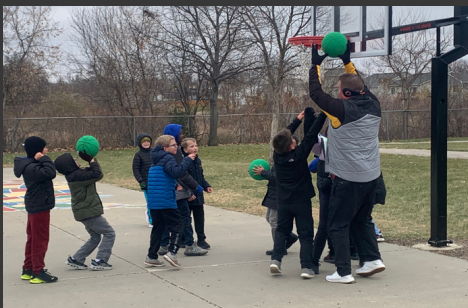

LEADER IN ME - HABIT 3: PUT FIRST THINGS FIRST

People who put first things first focus on the important, not just the urgent, act on priorities, plan weekly and act daily. You are putting first things first when you organize your time around the most important things and eliminate the unimportant.

HABIT 3 AT HOME:

- Talk about what's most important to your family. Make a list of your family's top three big rocks.
- One-on-One Time with Family Members: Go on a "date" or casual one-on-one activity with a family member. It does not need to be expensive. Ask what they would like to do, such as go for a walk, have a picnic, play a game, or work on a puzzle. Listen to them and affirm their worth and potential.
- Family Gratitude Dinner: Turn off all distractions. Gather around the table for a family meal. Invite family members to take turns sharing what they are most grateful for in their life. Encourage family members to take turns sharing why they are grateful for each other.
- Hold Regular Family Meetings
- Try limiting screen time to just 30 minutes per day and focusing on your Big Rocks you prioritized instead of screen time.
