#### PRINCIPAL/TEACHER UPDATE

Leader in Me Grant – prairie meadows - \$20,000

- Signs in hallways, announcements digital board, Wildly Important Goals scoreboard, murals

Delaware asked to speak at Iowa Best Summit

- Data - lower percentage of chronic absenteeism 23% (missed 18 days or more)
- Decreased the number of absenteeism across the board
- State assessments improvements
- Document that lays out information
- Teachers to contact every parent to check in
- Send at least 5 postcards out in the month
- Biggest piece – relationship between home and school
- Looking at implementing a Coffee and Conversations with Chelsea – low-key parent conversations – creating open dialogue between school and home
