THE YEAR IS OFF TO A GREAT START AND I HOPE THAT YOUR CHILDREN ARE TELLING YOU ALL ABOUT THE FUN THINGS GOING ON DURING PE CLASS. A QUICK REMINDER-STUDENTS MEET TWICE A WEEK FOR PE AND TENNIS SHOES ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED. WE HAVE BEEN SEEING SOME FOOTWEAR NOT CONDUCIVE TO EXERCISE. PE IS ALL ABOUT BEING ACTIVE, WHILE ALSO BEING SAFE. LET ME KNOW IF YOU NEED HELP GETTING SHOES FOR YOUR CHILD.

LOOKING AHEAD, K-2 WILL CONTINUE TO LEARN ABOUT SAFE SPATIAL AWARENESS DURING LARGE GROUP PLAY AND EXPERIMENTING WITH BASIC AND ADVANCED LOCOMOTOR SKILLS. I CONTINUE TO BE AMAZED AT THE PARTICIPATION LEVEL OF YOUNG CHILDREN AND HOW MUCH THEY LOVE TO MOVE.

GRADES 3-5 WILL BE CONCENTRATING A LARGE PORTION OF THEIR TIME FOR FITNESS TESTING. A FEW ASSESSMENTS COMING UP WILL BE 1) THE PACER, WHICH TESTS CARDIOVASCULAR ENDURANCE, 2) SHUTTLE RUN, WHICH ASSESSES SPEED IN A SHORT DISTANCE, AND 3) TIMED SIT UPS, WHICH TESTS YOUR CORE STRENGTH.

FINALLY, ASK YOUR CHILD IF THEY KNOW WHAT "SHOW ME 3" MEANS IN PE. A CRITICAL PART OF LEARNING IS THE ABILITY TO LISTEN. WE CONTINUALLY STRESS THE "SHOW ME 3" WHICH IS A QUIET BODY, QUIET VOICE, AND EYES ON THE TEACHER. GREAT LISTENING USUALLY MEANS A GREAT EXPERIENCE IN PE.

Upcoming Projects: All grade levels will begin a clay project in November!




MEDIA & LIBRARY WITH MRS. BARTELS
