LEADER IN ME - HABIT 6: SYNERGIZE

Synergy means collaborating to create 3rd Alternatives rather than settling for a compromise. When we Synergize, the whole is greater than the sum of its parts-one plus one equals three or more.

HABIT 6 AT HOME:

- Landscape Artwork Resources: Give each family member a blank piece of paper. Invite each person to draw a beautiful picture of a mountain scene. Have everyone hold up their finished pictures and show each other. Next, invite everyone to work together to draw a beautiful mountain scene on a large piece of paper. It's okay for everyone to draw at once. Discuss what happens when working together as a team. Did everyone have different ways to contribute? Did individuals build on each other's ideas? How did it feel to creatively cooperate? This is synergy!
- Stronger Together: Give each family member a popsicle stick. Ask them to each try to break their stick. Was it easy? Now give someone several popsicle sticks and ask them to try to break them all. Chances are they won't be able to break the bundle. Ask why that is the case and have a discussion about how the family united together is stronger than one person alone.

MEASURABLE RESULTS ASSESSMENT

To measure the positive outcomes achieved with Leader in Me, we will again use the Measurable Results Assessment. The MRA is a tool used to annually collect, analyze, and report student, staff, and school-level outcomes related to the Leader in Me's focus on leadership, culture, and academics. It can be used to help a school identify their strengths and weaknesses, develop goal-centered improvement plans, and monitor progress toward school improvement.
