



How will the process work?

At the right, there is a picture of a pinpad similar to the one at your student's school. Students will push each individual number until their full 5 digits are showing in the top box (right below the words "AlphaTech"). Once all numbers are showing, they will push the enter button. The Food & Nutrition Professional will then verify the student record the meal and they will continue through the line to get their meal.
