## RhythAMetteS Dance Clinic 2019 for dancers in grades PreK-5

<u>Dance Clinic Date & Time:</u> Saturday, March 2, from 9 a.m.- noon. Please be sure your child has someone to pick her up on time.

Performance Date & Time: RhythAMetteS Spring Show, Sunday, March 3. PreK-1st grade girls will perform at the 1:00 show. 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade girls will perform at the 6:00 show.

<u>Location:</u> The clinic will be at SE Polk High School in the Commons Area. The performance will be in the High School auditorium (right next to the commons).

<u>Cost:</u> \$35.00 per student, which includes a t-shirt, poms, snacks, dance instruction, and the student's ticket into the RhythAMette show. If paying by check, please make payable to SEP RhythAMetteS. Any other spectators wanting to come and watch the performance will need a ticket for the show.

<u>Tickets:</u> For those of you who have done our clinic before, this is a change. We will not be selling tickets through the Activities Office this year! Instead we will have a few nights set aside where you can come out to the high school commons area and purchase your tickets. We will also sell tickets the day of the clinic, but it is recommended to purchase them ahead of time if possible as they usually go pretty quickly. This will also help you avoid a long line the morning of the clinic or the day of the show.

Ticket sales are at the high school in the commons, and times are as follows:

- February 12, 6:00-7:30 p.m.
- February 19, 6:00-7:30 p.m.
- February 21, 6:00-7:30 p.m.

<u>Attire:</u> Students are to wear comfortable clothes of any color (dancewear, sweats, etc.) to the clinic and either tennis shoes or dance shoes. For the performance, the students need to wear the clinic t-shirt, black shorts or pants, and either jazz shoes or tennis shoes. Many girls choose

to decorate their shirt with rhinestones, ribbons, etc. before the show. This is just fine if you choose to do so, but is also not a requirement.

<u>Directors:</u> RhythAMetteS coaches, Marianne Peterson, Angie Beenen, Stacey Bouchard, and Becca Templeton will direct the clinic. Members of the award-winning, state, regional, and national champion, Southeast Polk RhythAMetteS dance team will be teaching the dance to the girls the day of the clinic.
