**Prevention and Mitigation Costs** – Cleaning and sanitary supplies, personnel costs associated with additional cleaning/sanitation, personal protective equipment (PPE), contact tracing software, medical claims due to tests, vaccinations, and treatment.

**Continuity of Operations/Services** – Online learning service software, internet accessibility, technology devices and support, long-term certified teacher substitutes.

**Evidence-Based Interventions** – Personnel costs related to summer school and mentoring, at-risk and learning loss interventionists, curriculum resource materials, professional development services and materials to address social and emotional needs of students, counseling services.
