The University of Iowa is hosting its annual Alumni and Friends Flash Writing Contest—a timed, online short story competition. We'll provide you with a writing prompt that includes a genre and a specific object to incorporate into your story. You'll have 48 hours and up to 1,000 words to come up with the rest.

Contest Categories

- Grades 3-4
- Grades 5-6
- Grades 7-8
- Grades 9-12
- Adult

How it works:

- **Theme:** A prompt that includes a character, an object, and genre to incorporate into your story will be posted on the Write Now website (foriowa.org/write-now) on Friday, January 14 at 4:00 p.m. CST
- **Length:** The maximum length for each short story is 1,000 words, not including the title page. Entries with more than 1,000 words will be disqualified.
- **Submit:** Before January 16 at 4:00 p.m. CST, submit your entry online at: foriowa.org/write-now.

Entries for minor-aged contest participants (under age 18) must be submitted by a parent or guardian.

One winner in each age category will receive an Iowa writing pack and a \$25 Bookshop.org gift card.
